## VISIT BY GREG BURY—ACA HIGH PERFORMANCE MANAGER FOR AC & GC

He mainly concentrated on coaching philosophies but he also devoted a day with the GC State Squad, providing hints on how to improve. He also spent half days with interested players of both GC & AC. Almost 100 people benefited from his time here.

Much of Greg's mantra is knowing what you are capable of and never under estimating the opposition. He was very keen for players to develop a set of drills in which they actively recorded their results so that they can see whether or not they have been improving.

## **COACHING COURSES FOR GOLF CROQUET PLAYERS**


Calling all GC players who want to improve their knowledge of the game by becoming qualified as a coach. Barry Haydon, our State coaching coordinator, is offering two coaching courses as follows:

Level 0 to be held on Wednesday 25th March at Hutt Rd from 9.30 to 12.15. Prerequisite – having played the game for at least 12 months

Level 1 to be held on Wednesday 1 April at Hutt Road from 9.30 to 12.15. Pre-requisite – Level 0 certificate and completion of AIS on-line General Coaching Principles course – see <a href="http://www.ausport.gov.au/participating/coaches/education/generalprinciples">http://www.ausport.gov.au/participating/coaches/education/generalprinciples</a>

A forecast temperature over **32 degrees but not over 34 degrees** games may be played, but must finish no later than 1.30pm

A forecast temperature over **34 degrees but not over 36 degrees** no play between 11am and 7pm. Games not likely to finish before 11am must not be started.

A forecast temperature **over 36 degrees** no daytime games will be played.

**Night Time play**. A forecast temperature of **38 degrees** or higher no night time games will be played.
