#### **XVII AUSTRALIAN MASTERS GAMES - ADELAIDE**

Croquet SA was pleased to participate in the XVII Australian Masters Games, with croquet being played at HQ from 5<sup>th</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup> October. It afforded an opportunity to showcase the sport to the wider community. Events contested were GC Doubles and Singles and AC Handicap Singles. The BBQ, which was held on Tuesday 8<sup>th</sup> October so as not to clash with Masters Games organised entertainment, was well supported as was the canteen which ran throughout the week.

Many thanks to the GC and AC referees who gave up their time to officiate during the competition. Thanks also to the members of Norwood, Millswood, Hyde Park, South Terrace, Woodville and Salisbury clubs who all volunteered to manage the event for a day. Their tasks were many and varied. A vote of thanks must also go to the organising committee for their hard work leading up to the event. Very positive feedback about the organisation, management and friendly atmosphere of the Games has been received from the players, particularly the interstate visitors. It is the efforts of all the volunteers which made the event an enjoyable and pleasant experience for the competitors.

Nine pairs participated in the GC Doubles being split into 2 blocks based on combined handicaps. The 18 players in the singles were split into 3 blocks, Open, 8+ and 10+.

# SOUTH AUSTRALIAN INAUGURAL U21 GOLF CROQUET CHAMPIONSHIPS 1<sup>ST</sup> – 3<sup>RD</sup> OCTOBER 2019

Following on from the success of the National Golf Croquet Championships held for the first time in Adelaide last January, which attracted participants from Tasmania, Victoria, ACT, NSW, rural and metro SA, Croquet SA decided to hold its first ever State Championships for junior players, a new event that we are very excited to add to the annual calendar. This competition attracted 13 participants, aged 10 to 16 years, from Casterton Victoria, Woodville, Hyde Park, Norwood and Tumby Bay (10 boys and 3 girls). This is a great result for a sport that has around 57 registered junior players in Australia.

We were honoured that Adelaide City Councillor Arman Abrahimzadeh agreed to open our tournament on the 1st of October at 9am by hitting the first ball through a hoop and we



were grateful for Adelaide City Council's support of the purchase of 2 state of the art mallets for competitors and future participants to use, and purchase of a commemorative shirt for all participants.

The U21 Golf Croquet Committee would also like to acknowledge and thank Croquet SA president Eileen Ferguson and the volunteers (referees, scorers and caterers) that made the event such a success.

The singles tournament was well fought out in warm conditions with a round robin on day 1 to determine the finalists for day 2. Congratulations to Woodville players Marcus Hennigan, Chris Crook and Ethan McEnteggart-Larsen who placed  $1^{st}$ ,  $2^{nd}$  and  $3^{rd}$ .

The Doubles Competition was won by Bill Hollier (Tumby Bay) and George Walker (Hyde Park) with Marcus Hennigan (Woodville) and James Mason (Casterton) runners up. This competition had five pairs and was played in a round robin.

The U21 Golf Croquet Committee have already set the date for the next U21 Golf Croquet Championships 29<sup>th</sup> Sept to 1<sup>st</sup> October 2020. We would encourage any U21 players to consider taking part in next year's tournament. Coaching will be available in Adelaide for any players new to the game.
